It may seem way too early to be thinking about Christmas but we are trying to avoid the problems we had last year with the increased numbers for the Christmas party. It was a very encouraging problem to have but it caused a wait list and some delay in getting returned tickets to members and some disappointment. The RVS centre is now available for hire again and we are going to visit to check out the new manager, the cleanliness of the room, the leak and the electrics, all of which we have been assured have been improved. We are holding a booking at the Chestnuts for 13th Dec. as agreed but need to be sure it could accommodate the numbers wishing to go. Many of you have now been to The Chestnuts and we are interested in how you feel this compares with the RVS centre and how important having the bar is to you. We know that we are able to have 80 max at the RVS centre and to consider using General Foods we need to have considerably more people going to hold the cost at £10 per person. I have looked at the Freemasons hall which has a bar but would only take about 70 people. We are planning a dance at the Chestnuts which would help us to decide . many it could comfortably hold and still offer a degree of comfort and space to eat.
